Dear Parents/Carers

As you will be aware from the media, the combined teacher and school leadership trade unions will be taking industrial action on 30 November 2011.

The action (a one day strike) will result in class or whole school closures across the country.

The decision to close the school or send students home is never taken lightly, but in this instance, where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, I will have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety and well being of all students.

Following further information the most likely outcome will be that the school will close on 30 November 2011 for most students. However, we are currently making arrangement for students in Year 11 to be supervised in the morning to complete self supported study. Please complete and return the reply slip below, by 9.00am on Monday, 28 November 2011, to indicate whether your son/daughter would attend a self supported study session between 9.00am and noon on 30 November 2011. If your son/daughter is entitled to a Free School Meal, please also indicate whether you would wish us to provide a cold Free School Meal on Wednesday.

I do hope you understand that the steps that we need to take are due to reasons outside of our control and thank you in advance for your co-operation. If there are any changes to this, we will inform you immediately – and please refer to the school's website.
