Dear Parents

As you will be aware from the media, the combined teacher and school leadership trades unions will be taking industrial action on the 30 November 2011.

The action (a one day strike) will result in class or whole school closures across the country.

The decision to close the school or send students home is never taken lightly, but in this instance, where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, I will have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety and well being of all pupils.

We are aware that class/school closures inconvenience parents and carers and so I am writing to give you advance notice of the likely impact of the action on this school. If the action goes ahead, there is a possibility that the school will be closed to students for the day.

I will write to inform you of the closure of classes / the school as soon as the extent of the industrial action is confirmed.
