This will be a fully residential school based in a Cambridge college, and all accommodation, meals, social events, trips and lectures are included in the cost.

The 2009 Aspects of History Summer School will cover various aspects of history, such as the history of art and architecture, archaeology and anthropology, local history, history of science and medicine, museum conservation and public heritage, along with a mix of academic lectures on various important periods in world history.

There will also be numerous study trips during the week including the Fitzwilliam Museum, the Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology, the exhibition “A Voyage Around The World: Charles Darwin and the Beagle Collections in the University of Cambridge” in the University Library and the collections of the Churchill Archives. As well as a full day Historical Mystery Tour, there will also be evening activities arranged including punting on the Cam, outdoor theatre in King’s College Garden and lots of other fun!

Students should note that the content of this week will be academically challenging and focused exclusively on history. It is aimed at gifted and talented students with a passion for this subject and who think they may like to study history at university

Students must be taking GCSE History and a supporting statement from their History Teacher is required

There are 5 free places and 13 half price places available based on a student’s household income. Details of the criteria for these subsidised places are available in the application form. Applications are not accepted on a “first come” basis and all those received by the closing date will receive equal consideration.
