

Upper School Uniform

- Plain black skirt or trousers
- Persian blue polo shirt with Chantry Logo (*Purchased from school only*)
- V-neck or Round Neck Black Pullover with Chantry Logo (*Purchased from school only*)
- White, grey or black socks. Plain tights in natural, grey or black.
- Plain black leather shoes with medium or low heels (*No shoes with visible logos, platform soles or heels with narrow ends, no backless shoes, no canvas shoes*)
- Plain dark jackets or coats to be worn. (*No leather or denim outdoor coats are allowed*)

The school has a supply of footwear which students will be required to wear if they come to school without black shoes. The only exception is when a medical doctor's note is produced.

Please note:

- No make-up or nail varnish to be worn.
- Jewellery: **one ear stud** in each ear, **one signet ring** and **one chain** worn under the shirt.
- Facial piercings including tongue studs, nose studs and eyebrow studs/bars are not allowed. A plastic retainer can be worn. No other facial jewellery is allowed.
- T-shirts should not be worn under polo shirts.
- Trainers may only be worn for games lessons. They should not be worn around the school.
- No caps or hats should be worn inside school buildings.
- Hair styles and hair colours should be appropriate. Extreme styles/colours are not allowed.
- Pupils who fail to comply with our uniform code may be withdrawn from lessons and educated away from peers. They may also be withdrawn at breaks and lunchtimes. They may also be asked to return home to change.

Should any problems arise over these guidelines for reasons of religious belief, we will be pleased to discuss them and agree some mutually acceptable clothing.

Year 10 pupils can continue to wear the school long sleeved black sweatshirt, zipped sweatshirt with school logo, or they can wear the new school pullovers.

Year 11 can wear the school long sleeved black sweatshirt or a plain black V-neck jumper or zipped sweatshirt with school logo.

Note

The school retains the right to decide what is appropriate school uniform and may respond to 'fashion' items as it sees fit.

PE Kit

Indoors and Summer Kit:

- Plain white short sleeved sports shirt
- Plain navy blue (shadow stripe) shorts;
- White ankle socks
- Non-marking trainers (for gymnastics no socks or trainers are to be worn)

Outdoor Kit (Winter):

- Plain white short sleeved sports shirt

- Plain navy blue (shadow stripe) shorts
- Long black football socks (for rugby, hockey, football)
- Football boots or sensible footwear
- Shin-pads (for hockey and football)

Optional:

- Black rugby shirt (bought from school)
- Plain navy blue sweatshirt (no hoodies)
- Plain navy jogging bottoms or tracksuit bottoms.

Please note that as a matter of Health and Safety, all jewellery, particularly ear studs, must be removed for PE or Games. Long hair must be tied back.

If a pupil is ill or injured they are still expected to bring along their kit so that they can still participate in some way in the lesson (e.g. as a coach or referee). As mentioned previously, parents should provide a note which explains why their son/daughter cannot participate fully so that we are aware of the problem.
